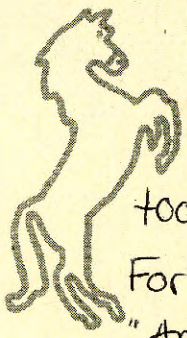


May 23rd, may letter
